For Security Guard Services

The following additions and/or clarifications are made to RLI #2010-BRAA-001 (the “RLI”):

1. For your reference, a diagram of the Boca Raton Airport is available at www.bocairport.com/airport-diagram.html.
2. The Boca Raton Airport Authority will not entertain offers to piggyback on other government contracts at this time.
3. The current provider of security guard services is Marksman Security Corporation (“Marksman”). The Boca Raton Airport Authority’s agreement with Marksman expires on April 30, 2010.
4. The rules adopted by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security implementing Chemical Facility Anti-Terrorism Standards (CFATS) do not apply to the Boca Raton Airport or the Boca Raton Airport Authority.
5. The Boca Raton Airport Authority uses its own security card system, and Transportation Worker Identification Credentials will not be required.
6. The Boca Raton Airport Authority does not provide passenger security. Passenger security is the responsibility of the Boca Raton Airport’s Fix Based Operators (“FBOs”).
7. Prospective respondents to the RLI may arrange for a tour of the Boca Raton Airport by contacting Paul McDermott at 561-391-2202.
8. Short-Listed Respondents and any employee or principle of a Short-Listed Respondent desiring to attend the Interview Phase of this RLI will be required to sign a Confidentiality Agreement with the Boca Raton Airport Authority.

Prospective Respondents to this RLI are reminded that information about security at the Boca Raton Airport is confidential and exempt from Sections 119.07(1) and 286.011, Florida Statutes. This RLI has been designed to keep any information related to the provision of security and/or security guard services at the Boca Raton Airport confidential.

Please note that details related to the scope of work will be revealed during the Interview Phase of this RLI.
